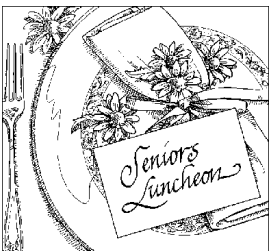
NC Baptist Women's Missions & Ministries

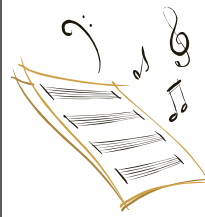
