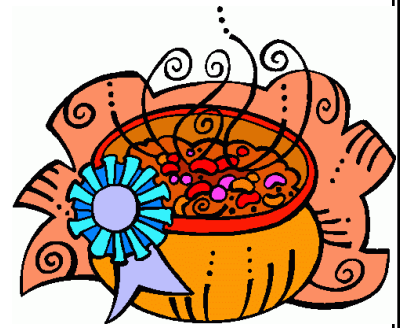
Happy New Year! Can you believe it? 2014? Time to start thinking about Caswell already. Hopefully each of you will be able to go and maybe even take a friend with us.
