They tend to dry and rot!

- Picture a runner crossing the finish line in a close race
- Every muscle and fiber is aiming toward the ribbon stretched across the track
- This leaves the runner very vulnerable
- You could push them right over

Vulnerable to criticism:

- You are wrong – it won't work
- It is not important
- I knew you could do it and thought about doing it myself

Vulnerable to misunderstandings:

- People will feel threatened
- They react by questioning your motives
- The people that know you then won't like you when you ask them to stretch

Vulnerable to discouragement:

- From others
- From self
- From the enemy

Over the next few months I am going to ask us all to stretch some as I think we all have become a little too comfortable. Let's stretch so that we can be all that God would have us to be for our good and His glory. This has challenged and convicted me in my life and I hope that it will be a help to our church as well.

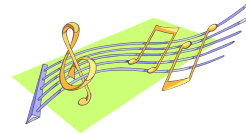
